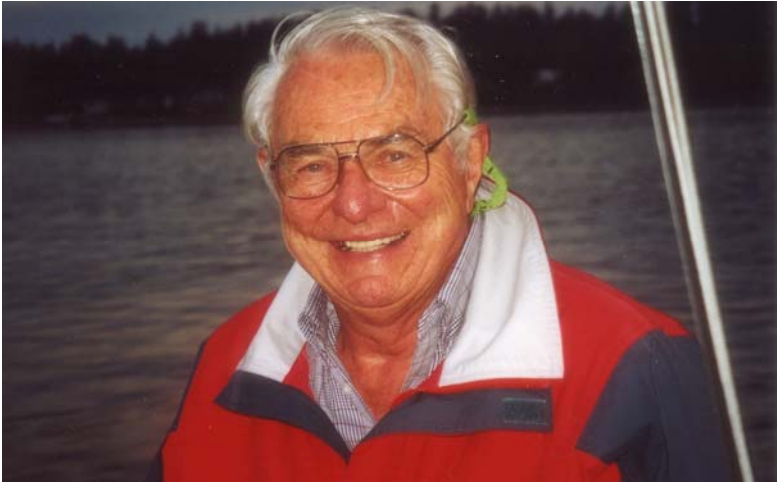


Jerre D. Noe
